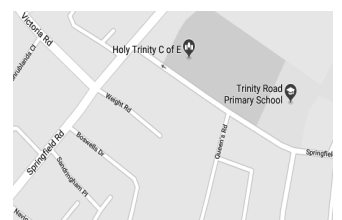
### Sunday Seat Booking
